

Media Consent Policy

Last updated: May 2026

WICE (“Where Internationals Connect in English”) occasionally photographs or records events, activities, workshops, volunteer initiatives, and community gatherings for communication, promotional, archival, and educational purposes.

This policy explains how photographs, video recordings, and other media may be collected and used by WICE.

1. Purpose of Media Collection

Photos and videos may be used to:

- Promote WICE activities and programs
- Illustrate community life and events
- Support newsletters, blog articles, and social media communication
- Create printed or digital promotional materials
- Document the history and activities of the organization

WICE strives to represent its community respectfully, authentically, and inclusively.

2. Where Media May Appear

Images or recordings may appear in:

- The WICE website
- WICE Direct newsletters
- Blog articles
- Social media platforms
- Event materials and promotional graphics
- Printed communication materials
- Internal presentations or reports

3. Consent

Where appropriate, WICE will seek consent before publishing clearly identifiable photographs or recordings of individuals.

By participating in public WICE events or activities, participants acknowledge that photography or filming may occasionally take place.

WICE will make reasonable efforts to inform participants when media is being captured during events.

4. Withdrawal of Consent

Any individual may request the removal of a specific image or recording in which they appear by contacting WICE directly.

WICE will make reasonable efforts to remove or discontinue future use of the requested media where feasible.

Please note that previously distributed or published materials may not always be fully retractable, particularly on third-party platforms or archived content.

5. Children & Minors

WICE does not knowingly publish identifiable images of minors without appropriate consent from a parent or legal guardian.

6. Respectful Use of Media

WICE is committed to using photographs and media responsibly and respectfully. Media will not knowingly be used in a misleading, harmful, defamatory, or inappropriate manner.

7. Third-Party Photography

Certain events may occasionally involve external photographers, media contributors, or collaborative partners. In such cases, WICE will seek to ensure that media usage aligns with this policy and applicable privacy regulations.
